
Brain Injury Awareness Month

At Life Connections, skilled providers are trained to help lowans make authentic, lasting connections with licensed, skilled providers. Their services extend throughout 13 lowa offices, 5 clinics, and approved schools. Life Connections was founded in March of 2009 with the intent to serve the children and families of lowa. They offer Mental Health therapy, Behavioral Health Intervention Services (BHIS), Childrens Mental Health Waiver services, Applied Behavioral Analysis (ABA), School Based Therapy, and Medication Management.
